During our initial phone consultation, you will be informed as to which of the following codes you should tell your insurance company.

They will be the best estimate based on the information you provide but may change after the formal evaluation.

### **Speech Therapy CPT (procedure) Codes:**

- 92507—treatment or the individual therapy sessions
- 92522—evaluation for speech sound production
- 92523—evaluation for speech AND language skills

### **Speech Therapy Diagnosis (ICD-10) Codes:**

- F80.0—articulation/phonology disorder
- F80.1—expressive language disorder
- F80.2—mixed receptive-expressive language disorder
- F80.4—speech & language delay due to hearing loss (chronic ear infection)
- F80.81—childhood onset fluency (stuttering) disorder

**Ask these questions while speaking with your insurance company.**

What is my coverage?

Do I need pre-authorization for speech therapy? If so, how to I obtain it?

What forms do I need to submit when filing my claim?

Where can I find the form on your website?

Can you email me a copy?

Can I file my claim online or do I need to mail/fax it to you?

Do I need to file my claim within a certain amount of time after the date of service?

Do I need a superbill from the speech therapist?

Do you need any other information from the speech therapist?

How long does it take to process my claim?

What can I do if you deny the insurance claim?
